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## Provider Guide to Long-Acting Reversible Contraception (LARCs)

#### ABOUT THIS GUIDE

This resource guide includes information on clinical settings in Philadelphia and surrounding counties that provide long-acting reversible contraception (LARCs). LARCS are the **most effective** contraceptives currently on the market.

Long-acting reversible contraception includes both

- the implant and
- intrauterine devices (IUDs)

FAMILY PLANNING & REPRODUCTIVE LIFE PLAN

A key component of any family planning visit is assessing a client's pregnancy intention and reproductive life plan (RLP). Discussions about a client's RLP include preconception health and contraceptive counseling and are most effective when childbearing plans are discussed on an ongoing basis.

Asking about pregnancy plans for the next twelve months at regular and frequent intervals, including during pregnancy, effectively reveals those not actively seeking pregnancy in the next year and prompts further discussion of family planning.

Men, women, and adolescents should all participate in these discussions with their health care providers.
